

Yandle, William Edward LAFAYETTE-- Funeral services will be held at a 10 a.m. Mass of Christian Burial Saturday, Nov. 6, 2004, in the Delhomme Chapel of the Flowers for William Edward Yandle, 71, who died at 3:45 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 4, 2004, at Lafayette General Medical Center.
