Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday, Nov. 15, 1996 in the Delhomme Bertrand Chapel of the Flowers for David Richard Schnaars, 74, who died at 2:45 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 12, 1996 at his residence.

Interment will take place in Lafayette Memorial Park Cemetery. The Rev. Randy Curtis, Bethel Baptist Church, will officiate.

David, son of the late David Richard Schnaars and the former Emma Muller, was a native of Brooklyn, New York. He had resided in Lafayette since 1988.

A Mechanical Engineer, Mr. Schnaars retired from TRW in Danville, Penn., after 28 years of employment. A First Lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force, he was a copilot on a B-17 in the 8th Air Force during World War II. He was shot down and was a Prisoner of War for 10 months.

After retirement, Mr. Schnaars was a volunteer with the Social Security Administration. He was a member of the Mahoning Presbyterian Church in Danville.

Survivors include: his wife, Irene Lamenzo Schnaars of Maurice; three sons, Daniel R. Schnaars of Lafayette, Donald R. Schnaars of Virginia Beach, Va., and David R. He was preceded in death by his parents, and one brother, Henry Schnaars.
